**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CRITERIA AND PROCESS FOR  
NOMINATION OF SECTORAL REPRESENTATIVES TO THE  
NATIONAL COUNCIL AGAINST CHILD LABOR**

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 92 was signed by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte on 17 September 2019 to institutionalize the National Council Against Child Labor to amplify government efforts for the protection of the rights of vulnerable sectors, especially the children, strengthen related institutional mechanisms, and establish further measures that will contribute to the prevention, reduction and elimination of any form of child labor;

**WHEREAS**, Section 1 of Executive Order No. 92 provides that the Council shall be composed of the heads of the following government agencies: Department of Labor and Employment; Department of Social Welfare and Development; Department of Education; Department of Health; Department of the Interior and Local Government; Department of Justice; Department of Agriculture; Department of Environment and Natural Resources; National Commission on Muslim Filipinos; National Economic and Development Authority; Philippine Information Agency; Technical Education and Skills Development Authority; Council for the Welfare of Children; National Youth Commission; National Commission on Indigenous Peoples; Philippine Statistics Authority; Philippine National Police; National Bureau of Investigation; and Basic Sector on Children of the National Anti-Poverty Commission;

**WHEREAS**, Section 1 of Executive Order No. 92 further provides that apart from these government agencies, the Council shall also include as members two (2) representatives from the workers sector, two (2) representatives from the employers sector, and two (2) representatives from non-government organizations with programs on child labor, who shall be nominated by the sectors themselves, for appointment by the President for a term of three (3) years, without prejudice to reappointment;

**WHEREAS**, during the first organizational meeting of the Council on 16 January 2020 at the Swiss-Belhotel Blulane, Sta. Cruz, Manila, the criteria and process for nomination of sectoral representatives to the National Council Against Child Labor were discussed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Council members approve the criteria and process for nomination of sectoral representatives to the National Council Against Child Labor (Annex A);

**BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER** that the Council members request the Department of Labor and Employment, as Chair of the Council, to disseminate to the workers sector, employers sector, and non-government organizations a call for nomination as sectoral representatives to the National Council Against Child Labor.



# NATIONAL COUNCIL AGAINST CHILD LABOR

## CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION OF SECTORAL REPRESENTATIVES

The Sectoral Representatives shall have the following minimum qualifications:

### A. Workers Sector

#### 1. *Organization*

- a. Organized in accordance with Philippine laws
- b. Duly registered with the Department of Labor and Employment as a legitimate labor organization
- c. Existing and operating for at least five (5) years
- d. With proven record of involvement towards the prevention and elimination of child labor
- e. With no pending criminal case filed before any office, court or tribunal

#### 2. *Individual representative*

- a. Filipino citizen
- b. Knowledgeable on dynamics of child labor and other related issues
- c. Actively involved in their organization's efforts against child labor
- d. Willing, available, and competent to perform the functions as a sectoral representative
- e. With proven integrity and probity
- f. With no pending criminal case filed before any office, court or tribunal

### B. Employers Sector

#### 1. *Organization*

- a. Organized in accordance with Philippine laws
- b. Duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission
- c. Existing and operating for at least five (5) years
- d. With proven record of involvement towards the prevention and elimination of child labor
- e. With no pending criminal case filed before any office, court or tribunal

#### 2. *Individual representative*

- a. Filipino citizen
- b. Knowledgeable on dynamics of child labor and other related issues
- c. Actively involved in their organization's efforts against child labor

- d. Willing, available, and competent to perform the functions as a sectoral representative
- e. With proven integrity and probity
- f. With no pending criminal case filed before any office, court or tribunal

## **C. Non-Government Organization**

### **1. Organization**

- a. Organized in accordance with Philippine laws
- b. Duly accredited by the Department of Social Welfare and Development
- c. Existing and operating for at least five (5) years
- d. Operating in at least two (2) regions
- e. With proven record of involvement towards the prevention and elimination of child labor
- f. With no pending criminal case filed before any office, court or tribunal

### **2. Individual representative**

- a. Filipino citizen
- b. Knowledgeable on dynamics of child labor and other related issues
- c. Actively involved in their organization's efforts against child labor
- d. Willing, available, and competent to perform the functions as a sectoral representative
- e. With proven integrity and probity
- f. With no pending criminal case filed before any office, court or tribunal

# NATIONAL COUNCIL AGAINST CHILD LABOR

## PROCESS FOR NOMINATION OF SECTORAL REPRESENTATIVES (Workers Sector, Employers Sector, Non-Government Organizations)

1. A call for nomination shall be disseminated by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) as Chair of the National Council Against Child Labor.
2. The workers sector, employers sector, non-government organizations, members of the Council, and other stakeholders shall submit nominees to the Council, based on the set criteria.
3. The nominated organizations shall be required to submit the following documents to the Council, through the Council Secretariat at e-mail address [ncacl.secretariat@gmail.com](mailto:ncacl.secretariat@gmail.com):
  - a. Accomplished Nomination Form;
  - b. Certificate of Registration from the DOLE for **workers sector**; Certificate of Incorporation from the Securities and Exchange Commission for **employers sector**; Certificate of Accreditation from the Department of Social Welfare and Development for **non-government organizations**;
  - c. Names, address, and contact details of the current directors, trustees, officers and key personnel of the nominee;
  - d. Name, designation and contact details of organization's proposed individual representative; and
  - e. List of child labor-related involvement of the organization and its individual nominee.
4. The Council shall deliberate on the qualifications of the nominees and shall shortlist them by majority vote of the member-government agencies of the Council.
5. The Council shall submit to the Office of the President the shortlisted nominees.
