FOR SECTORAL REPRESENTATIVES TO THE NATIONAL COUNCIL AGAINST CHILD LABOR (EMPLOYERS SECTOR)


The National Council Against Child Labor is pleased to announce that **nominations for employers sector representatives to the Council are now being accepted.**

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 92, the National Council Against Child Labor shall be composed of the heads of the following government agencies: Department of Labor and Employment; Department of Social Welfare and Development; Department of Education; Department of Health; Department of the Interior and Local Government; Department of Justice; Department of Agriculture; Department of Environment and Natural Resources; National Commission on Muslim Filipinos; Department of Economy, Planning, and Development; Philippine Information Agency; Technical Education and Skills Development Authority; Council for the Welfare of Children; National Youth Commission; National Commission on Indigenous Peoples; Philippine Statistics Authority; Philippine National Police; National Bureau of Investigation; Basic Sector on Children of the National Anti-Poverty Commission; and, Presidential Office for Child Protection.

Apart from these government agencies, the Council shall also include as members two (2) representatives each from the workers sector, employers sector, and non-government organizations with programs on child labor, who shall be nominated by the sectors themselves, for appointment by the President for a term of three (3) years, without prejudice to reappointment.

You may submit your nominations, together with the documentary requirements to the Council Secretariat through e-mail address ncacl.secretariat@bwsc.dole.gov.ph **on or before 30 April 2026** using the attached Nomination Form.

EMPLOYERS SECTOR Criteria for Nomination

1. Organization

- a. Organized in accordance with Philippine laws
- b. Duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission
- c. Existing and operating for at least five (5) years
- d. With proven record of involvement towards the prevention and elimination of child labor
- e. With no pending criminal case filed before any office, court, or tribunal

2. Individual representative

- a. Filipino citizen
- b. Knowledgeable on dynamics of child labor and other related issuances
- c. Actively involved in their organization's efforts against child labor
- d. Willing, available and competent to perform the functions as a sectoral representative
- e. With proven integrity and probity
- f. With no pending criminal case filed before any office, court, or tribunal

CALL FOR NOMINATION

for Sectoral Representatives to the National Council Against Child Labor

EMPLOYERS SECTOR Process for Nomination

1. A call for nomination shall be disseminated by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) as Chair of the National Council Against Child Labor.
2. The workers sector, employers sector, non-government organizations, members of the Council, and other stakeholders shall submit nominees to the Council based on the set criteria.
3. The nominated organizations shall be required to submit the following documents to the Council, through the Council Secretariat at email address **ncacl.secretariat@bwsc.dole.gov.ph**:
 - a. Accomplished Nomination Form
 - b. Certificate of Incorporation from the Securities and Exchange Commission
 - c. Names, address, and contact details of the current directors, trustees, officers and key personnel of the nominee
 - d. Name, designation and contact details of organization's proposed individual representative
 - e. List of child labor-related involvement of the organization and its individual nominee
4. The Council shall deliberate on the qualifications of the nominees and shall shortlist them by majority vote of the member-government agencies of the Council.
5. The Council shall submit to the Office of the President the shortlisted nominees.
